PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Right Skills Now Fast-Track Training is a 500+ hour program that will prepare adult students for a career in the manufacturing industry, offering 10 weeks of evening training and an 8-week paid internship. Right Skills Now is an acceleration of the National Association of Manufacturers (NAM) – Endorsed Manufacturing Skills Certification System.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Evening program: 10 weeks (25 hrs/week) of hands on, classroom training in a lab environment starting at 4pm, M-F.
- Opportunity to earn 2 certifications from the National Institute for Metalworking Skills (NIMS).
- All classes held at Kenmore Garfield High School in Akron.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- High school diploma or GED/HSE equivalent
- Skills validation of achieving a WorkKeys Assessment Level 4 in:
 - Applied Math
 - Locating Information
 - Reading for Information
- Ability to pass a drug screen
- Good attendance

INTERNSHIP

- 8 weeks at 40 hours per week
- Every student who meets agreed upon attendance and grade criteria is guaranteed an internship
- Hourly wage no less than \$12.00 per hour
- Full time employment not guaranteed at end of internship

PROGRAM COURSES and CREDITS

- Machine Tools – 3 credit hours
- CNC Programming – 4 credit hours
- Blueprint Reading – 2 credit hours
- OSHA 10 Certification – 1 credit hour
- Measurement, Materials & Processes – non credit

COMPANY REQUIREMENTS

- Guarantee to provide a paid internship to student(s) who meet the attendance and grade criteria
- Pay no less than \$12 per hour during the internship (although you can offer more)
- Participate in company preview and student interview sessions
- Provide an opportunity for students to visit and tour your facility prior to internship interviews

OUTCOMES

- Ability to bypass basic training and spend more time on processes and equipment
- An opportunity to see if the student is a fit with your organization before offering full time employment
- Savings on recruitment efforts – testing and basic training completed
